## REGULATIONS

### on the "**Pantheon of the CMH**" Prize

To promote and popularize proper trophy hunting, the Club of Mountain Hunters (hereinafter also referred to as the Club or CMH) establishes the "**Pantheon of the CMH**" Prize.

Eligible candidates for this prize are CMH members who are registered on the CMH website. The prize is awarded for **trophies** of male hunting animals (or females, only in the case of specific species such as chamois and American mountain goats) harvested personally by the nominee in compliance with current hunting regulations and ethical standards in their natural habitats. The trophies must be from animals listed in the CMH OVIS and CAPRA ranking lists.

Detailed information about the prize is available on the official CMH website.

#### Trophy Registration and Nomination Procedure:

- In the personal account on the official CMH website, the Club member must complete the trophy report form, upload a field photograph with the trophy, and, if necessary, provide a copy of the special hunting permit.

Submitted materials are reviewed by the Trophy Committee as they are received. When a member of the Club registers a number of trophies that meet the criteria for this prize, they will receive a notification from the Club Administration. The nominee will then be eligible to receive a certificate confirming the award. The award ceremony takes place at Club meetings in a formal setting.

The nominee's name will be listed in a special section on the "Pantheon CMH" website.

Information about all nominees will be posted on the CMH website in compliance with Federal Law No. 152-FL "On Personal Data." The names and photos of the hunters (and their trophies) may also be included in the CMH Trophy Book and published in the annual hunting calendar and other periodicals, following the requirements of Federal Law No. 152-FL "On Personal Data."
